

## **Amended Continuing Education Requirements for CIR and AIR Designations**

On June 11, 2004, IAIR's Board of Directors adopted new Continuing Education requirements applicable to the CIR® and AIR® designations, as well as new policies relating to those designations. The changes are as follows and shall take precedence over any conflicting provision of the *Standards for Accreditation* applicable to CIR and AIR designations.

### **1. Maintenance of Designation**

**CIR** designees must participate in approved continuing education activities of at least forty (40) hours every two years.

**AIR** designees must participate in approved continuing education activities of at least forty (40) hours every two years.

### **2. Implementation of New Requirements**

Currently - accredited CIR and AIR designees shall comply with the Continuing Education 40 hour maintenance requirements at the commencement of each designees' next two year compliance period.

### **3. Other Policies and Procedures**

1. Continuing Education credit for educational or training programs and activities will be granted in accordance with the Association's *Approved Continuing Education Activities and Accreditation Standards Applicable to Other CE Activities* currently in effect or subsequently adopted.
2. Designees will be subject to the Association's *Policies Concerning Compliance with Continuing Education Requirements by CIR and AIR Designees* currently in effect or subsequently adopted.
3. Designees will at all times comport themselves in accordance with the Association's *Code of Ethics* currently in effect or subsequently adopted.
4. Designees are subject to the Association's *Procedure for the Investigation and Disposition of Complaints Alleging Violations of the IAIR Code of Ethics* currently in effect or subsequently adopted.
